The Minister's Message

George Barna, a market researcher specializing in the study of religious beliefs, talked about this new generation of young adults and how they do not stand for any one real truth. 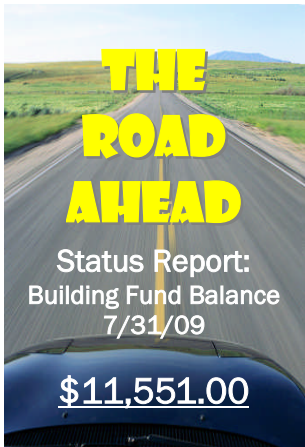

Election & Budget Approval Timeline

Sunday, August 2

The selection process begins for Elders & Deacons. If there is someone you think meets the biblical qualifications for these offices (see 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:5-9), please talk to him and ask if he would be interested in being considered for the position. The current Board of Elders will begin receiving these suggestions in writing from members of the congregation. Any active member is able to suggest a name. The suggestion process will conclude on the last Sunday of August.

Sunday, August 30

The deadline to submit suggestions in writing for the office of elder/deacon.

September

The elders enter into the review and interview process of the suggested candidates for elder/deacon.

October 1

The elder/deacon recommendations and the proposed 2010 budget will be published and available to the congregation.

October 18

There will be an Informational Meeting to present the nominees for elder/deacon and to review the proposed 2009 budget.

November 1

We will vote to approve the proposed 2009 budget and elect elders/deacons. This vote will be by secret ballot. To qualify to vote you must be 16 years of age and be an active member of SRCC.
