Help those in need of food to sustain their lives!

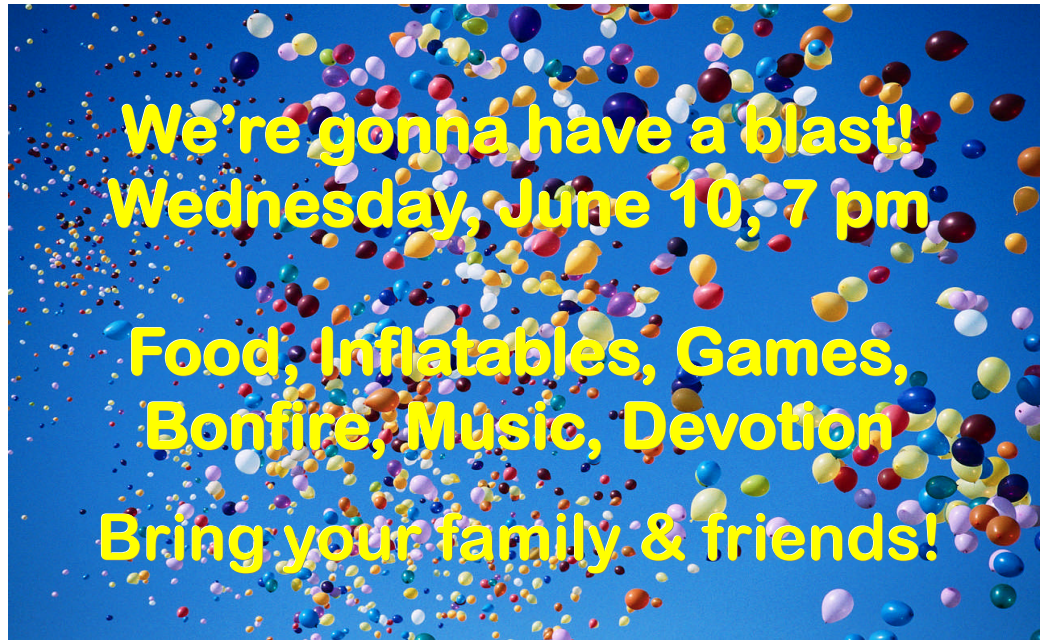
