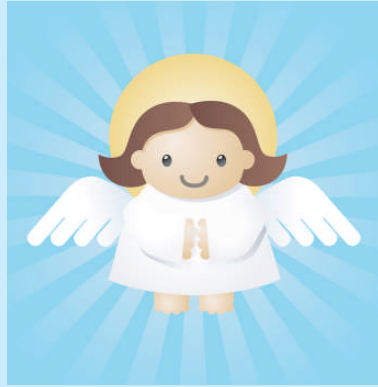
When I look at the church in its early stages, everyone had a role.

- 6) The Upward Closing Program will be held on Friday, November 6, 7 p.m. at First Coast High School gymnasium. Park in the teacher's lot.

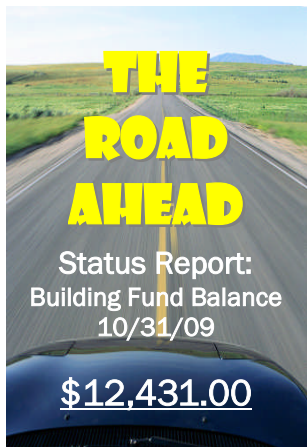
