The Minister's Message

In Milwaukee there was an accident where a SUV flipped over and caught fire. A mother and her two infant children were trapped in the burning vehicle. Several people who happened to be in the area came to the rescue freeing the mother through the window and the 2-year-old through the sunroof. Still trapped in the vehicle was a 4-year-old still strapped in his car seat. Neighbors and complete strang-

ers frantically worked to free him.

The good news is, D.J., the 4-year old boy who received severe burns over 20 percent of his body, is expected to make a full recovery. The day after the accident, a reporter on *ABC's World News Tonight* said people were walking around the scene wondering what might have been... "had strangers not acted more like family?"

Does this story not remind you of what the church is to be? We are to be the ones out there rescuing the trapped, the lost, the hurting. Every prayer prayed, song sung, sermon preached, gift given, kindness extended, or help offered in the name of JESUS total strangers, makes a HUGE difference. A difference that affects people's eternal destinies.*

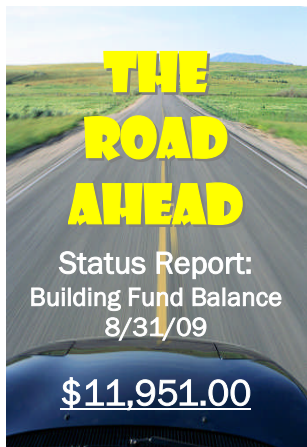

September

The elders enter into the review and interview process of the suggested candidates for elder/deacon.

October 1

The elder/deacon recommendations and the proposed 2010 budget will be published and available to the congregation.

October 18

There will be an Informational Meeting to present the nominees for elder/deacon and to review the proposed 2009 budget.

November 1

We will vote to approve the proposed 2009 budget and elect elders/deacons. This vote will be by secret ballot. To qualify to vote you must be 16 years of age and be an active member of SRCC.
